#### Vintage Conditions

The 2012 vintage in Drumborg was one of the great seasons for table wine in recent times. Low yields, slightly drier and warmer than average conditions produced stunning results. Riesling from Drumborg produced great purity and varietal character, all knitted together by its trademark structure.

Bright floral, lifted aromas, citrus pith and kaffir lime leaf, fresh granny smith apple peel, fruit purity, bright sherbet.

Minerally, fine line with gravel chalkiness, delicate structure persists braced by perfectly integrated acidity. Intense lemon and lime, light dried grasses and savoury nuances balanced by lovely texture and weight on the palate. A wine of balance, delicacy and intensity.
